- **All:** He authenticated their writings and ministry by means of supernatural gifts. He takes the things of Christ and sovereignly applies them to His people by calling, regenerating, sanctifying and glorifying them for Christ's eternal Kingdom.

- Four fundamental principles for this series (War of Words by Paul David Tripp)
 - o God has a wonderful plan for our words that is far better than any plan we could produce on our own. "...take every thought captive to obey Christ..." (2 Cor. 10:5)
 - o Sin has radically altered our agenda for our words, resulting in much hurt, confusion, and chaos. "ALL have Sinned and fall short of the Glory of God..." (Rom. 3:23)
